## Department in Damaris AM



### Technologies

R&D is working on three set of projects: Web applications, Desktop applications, Mobile applications

All our web application are based on Java EE Web Application technologies:

**J2EE JSF Hibernate Spring etc.**

Our desktop applications are based on .NET Framework.

For developing mobile applications we are using Mono framework which allows to build business logic using .NET and use it with Windows Phone, iPhone and Android, and the user interface I build based on native API. This solution allows us to have cross-platform solution with native UI.

### Projects

Currently we are working on Damaris III generation products which should be platform independent, full web and secure solutions.

It should be based on the new technologies and should satisfy current market requirements.

Damaris III generation products will consists of 3 parts:

- Web Applications which will provide all core functionalities
- Desktop Applications which will include only user specific functionalities like working with scanners, barcode readers etc.
- Mobile Applications which will provide additional features to our users.

R&D provides major release each year in September, as a result we update and rebuild allow existing solutions.

In addition each two month R&D provides service pack with the list of all updated applications.

### Interesting Facts About Archiving

- **57 %** of medium to large sized businesses have a need to manage their email server storage better by moving this data to a cheaper storage solution
- **46%** want something to aid them in handling their routine e-discovery requests
- **42%** require end users to be able to recover their old, deleted or missing emails
- **34%** have a requirement for email and other electronic data to be extracted in order to conform to regulatory audits.

These results show that there is a real need out there for organizations to have systems and policies in place to deal with these important aspects of their IT management.
